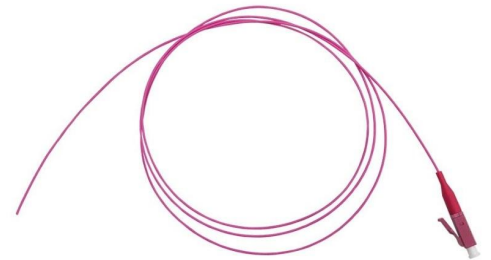


Fiber Optic Pigtail LC/UPC OM4 50/125 LSZH 2m Violet

Fiber optic pigtail is a short fiber optic cable that has an optical connector at one end and a length of exposed fiber at the other. The connector can be terminated with various types of connectors such as SC, LC, ST or FC. Pigtails are used to terminate fiber optic cables for devices and equipment. The exposed fiber at the other end of the cable is then spliced to the fiber in the main cable using melt-by-melt techniques or a mechanical splice. This allows for a fast and easy connection between the device and the fiber optic network. Fiber optic braids come in various lengths and colors to make identification and organization easier.
